

APRIL 2017 ENGINEERING WORK ALTERATIONS

Greater Anglia Operations

Sunday 2nd April

An hourly loco-hauled shuttle service shall operate between Norwich and Witham only with onward connections to London by bus and LUL tube.

The line between Colchester and Witham will be shut from 21:00hrs during the above period, which will result in late evening alterations for all services between London and Norwich. See link for more details.

Freightliner Operations

April 2017 Alterations

The GEML will be shut on a number of weekends during April including Easter. During these closures, all freights which usually use the GEML via Stratford will be diverted via Ely and Peterborough using diesel traction.

In addition, the WCML will be shut north of Carlisle over the Easter weekend, which means the Daventry to Coatbridge and vice-versa will be routed via the ECML using diesel traction throughout.

There was nothing else that needed to be reported on at the time of writing, but new engineering work closures occur on an ad-hoc basis, therefore this may affect the operations of Freightliner services using electric traction.
