Engineering work shall take place on the following dates between London and Norwich which will affect the operations of the loco-hauled diagrams – see links for more detailed information below.

### [Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> December](#)

Engineering work shall take place between Ipswich and Marks Tey until 08:40 affecting the first couple of services of the morning. Please note this is a last minute change by Network Rail.

### [Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> December](#)

Engineering work shall take place between Shenfield and London Liverpool Street resulting in amendments to the timetable. However, as far as I can tell this work does not impact on the Norwich to London services.

### [Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> December Christmas Eve](#)

Network Rail will carry out OHLE renewals between Ilford and Stratford all day in addition to an early shutdown of operations in the evening. Loco-hauled shuttles to run between Shenfield and Norwich with additional stops being made at Ingatestone for bus replacement.

### [Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> December](#)

Network Rail will carry out OHLE renewals between Ilford and Stratford all. Loco-hauled shuttles to run between Shenfield and Norwich with additional stops being made at Ingatestone for bus replacement.

### [Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> to Friday 30<sup>th</sup> December](#)

Network Rail will be continuing with their OHLE renewals between Ilford and Stratford during the above period. An amended timetable shall operate on all 3 days. See link for more details.

### [Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> December New Year's Eve](#)

Network Rail will carry out OHLE renewals between Ilford and Stratford all. Loco-hauled shuttles to run between Shenfield and Norwich with additional stops being made at Ingatestone for bus replacement.

In addition, the usual late night services operate on New Year's Eve meaning that you can once again take advantage of travelling by a class 90 at the stroke of midnight – see url link for more details.

### [Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> January 2012 New Year's Day](#)

Network Rail will carry out OHLE renewals between Ilford and Stratford all. Loco-hauled shuttles to run between Shenfield and Norwich with additional stops being made at Ingatestone for bus replacement.

### [Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> January 2012 Bank Holiday](#)

Network Rail will carry out OHLE renewals between Ilford and Stratford all. Loco-hauled shuttles to run between Shenfield and Norwich with additional stops being made at Ingatestone for bus replacement.

### [Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> January](#)

Late night engineering work from 22:00hrs between Ipswich, Stowmarket and Diss which will impact on the last few services of the day. Please see url link for more details.

### [Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> January](#)

Engineering work is due to take place between Stowmarket and Manningtree to include Colchester. Shuttles will run between Stowmarket and Norwich all day (likely to be loco-hauled). Services will also run between Colchester and London Liverpool Street – these are likely to be operated by units.

### [Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> January](#)

Late night engineering work from 22:00hrs between Ipswich, Stowmarket and Diss which will impact on the last few services of the day. Please see url link for more details.

### [Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> January](#)

There is a two part route closure for this day affecting the services between Norwich and London.

- Part 1 – buses replaces trains between Ipswich and Norwich all day.
- Part 2 – trains run between Ipswich and Witham for buses to Billericay

At this stage It is not known if the shuttles between Ipswich and Witham will be hauled, but suspect these will be, at least in part anyway.

## **Scotrail Sleepers**

No engineering work alterations to report on at the time of writing for the Scotrail Sleeper services. However, no sleeper services will run on the following dates due to the festive period:

- 25<sup>th</sup> December
- 26<sup>th</sup> December
- 27<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> December (normal sleeper operations)
- 1<sup>st</sup> January

On the night of January 2<sup>nd</sup> 2012, some journey times are extended to the sleepers due to engineering work – this mostly impact on the Edinburgh/Glasgow Lowlander service to Euston (1M11). More details on what is happening will be added here when known.
