ALL OPERATORS INCLUDING FREIGHTLINER

The service alterations shown below are for routes which class 90s operate on for Freightliner but similar alterations apply to other operators who do not use Class 90s.

West Coast Main Line

There is quite a bit disruption on the WCML during this period, I therefore urge people to check real-time data sources to see what trains are impacted and or cancelled/altered.

WCML / Scotland / Midlands / South / NW England:

- Sunday 6th April Carlisle northwards closed (diversions via ECML / GSW)
- Sunday 6th and 13th April Stafford to Wolverhampton closed (diversions and alterations apply).
- Sunday 13th April Preston northwards closed (diversions via ECML).
- Friday 18th April Tuesday 22nd April Milton Keynes Central southwards closed plus Carlisle northwards closed (diversions and alterations apply).

There were no other known alterations to report on at the time of publication.

East Anglia / GEML

- Saturday 5th & Sunday 6th April Colchester to Billericay closed all day (diversions apply for freight).
- Saturday 12th & Sunday 13th April Colchester to Billericay closed all day (diversions apply for freight)
- Sunday 20th and Monday 21st Colchester to Billericay closed all day (diversions apply for freight). Please also note that the WCML is shut south of Milton Keynes Central too.

• Tuesday 28th to Friday 2nd May – late night engineering work Witham to Colchester (diversions and alterations apply).

There were no other known alterations to report on at the time of publication. However, engineering work does take place on various sections of the GEML during the week and at weekends at short notice. It is advisable to check real-time data sources for specific trains on specific days just to be sure that the train you're looking for is a runner or diverted.
